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The **Suriname CARICOM Food Bank** is presented in the document as a regional platform designed to strengthen **food safety, food security, and emergency preparedness throughout the CARICOM islands**. From its strategic base in Suriname, the concept connects a Caribbean regional logistics hub with the storage, organization, and distribution of essential food, water, and disaster-relief supplies for participating island nations. The facility is envisioned to help maintain dependable reserves of critical products, coordinate regional distribution during normal operations, and rapidly mobilize supplies following hurricanes, flooding, natural disasters, or other disruptions to local food systems. The map in the document positions Suriname as the mainland supply and logistics center supporting countries across the Caribbean, while the regional hub imagery highlights food stocks, drinking water, emergency equipment, filtration systems, and disaster-response supplies. Together, the concept establishes Port Boskamp and Suriname as an important regional support point for improving the **availability, reliability, and resilience of the CARICOM food supply chain**, helping ensure that communities can maintain access to essential food and emergency resources when they are needed most.
